

SIS Summer Language Exercises for Incoming 6^e

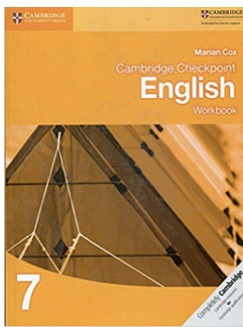
To help prepare your child for a smooth transition to the SIS programme, our teachers have selected a number of language exercises to complete over the summer along with the summer reading.
